Minutes of the Eleventh Academic Council Meeting

Venue: Conference Hall of the College

Date: 19-01-2019.

At the outset, Dr.Udaya Kumar Susarla, Principal extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council. Insipiently, the Minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting were ratified.

Principal in his presentation:

- Apprised the members on the major achievements of the college since last CAC.
- Presented the analysis of the examinations' results, malpractices cases and detention list of the students due to attendance shortage of various branches of engineering and PG programs .(M.B.A and M.Tech) pertaining to different years and semesters.
- Proposed for slight modification of the existing revaluation rule in case of failed students.
- Informed the members that the Academic Calendar has been slightly modified for B.Tech I Year students and for M.B.A. This was carried out as the examinations were postponed owing to the elections in the state. Subsequently, the instruction spell for B.Tech I year/II sem is postponed by four (4) days.
- Briefed the members on the details of end examinations scheduled during April-May, 2018.
- Informed the members that the Instruction spell of I.B.Tech for the next academic year is advanced by a week, that is academic year 2019-20 now commences from June 24, 2019 for II, III, and IV year classes.

Suggestions

- Dr.E.Saibaba Reddy, Prof. of Civil Engineering and Principal JNTUH-CEH recommended to include the reason for punishment in the existing format for malpractice cases for maintaining transparency.
- Dr.E.Saibaba Reddy, Prof. of Civil Engineering, and Principal JNTUH-CEH, suggested to undertake consultancy projects. The Head, CE Department responded positively and informed him about the developments as far as consultancy projects are concerned.
- Dr.P.G.Sastry suggested that the college faculty should work towards sustainable development

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- **All the members of the Academic Council unanimously suggested the following revision in the existing rule pertaining to revaluation. In case of failed students:**

1. The answer script of the student shall be valued by two independent evaluators.
2. If the student secures less than pass marks (<25 marks) in either of the revaluation (RV1 or RV2) the student shall be deemed to have failed.
3. If the student secures pass marks (≥ 25 marks) in both revaluations, the lower of the two marks shall be considered as final revaluation marks
4. If the final revaluation marks ≥ 25 and the sum total of the final revaluation marks and CIE marks is \geq or 40, the student shall be declared to have passed the course, else the student shall be declared as failed with the initial original marks awarded for the course remaining the same.

In case of passed students:

1. There shall be two revaluations RV1 and RV2.
 2. If $RV1 - RV2 < 12$ marks, Revaluation marks = $(RV1 \text{ marks} + RV2 \text{ marks}) / 2$.
 3. If $RV1 - RV2 \geq 12$ marks, there will be third revaluation
 4. If $(\text{Difference of RV3 and RV1}) < (\text{Difference of RV3 and RV2})$,
 - a. then Revaluation marks = $(RV3 \text{ marks} + RV1 \text{ marks}) / 2$
 - b. else Revaluation marks = $(RV3 \text{ marks} + RV2 \text{ marks}) / 2$.
 5. If Revaluation marks < Original marks, No change in the result
 - Else if Revaluation marks – Original marks ≤ 11 marks, No change in the result
 - else Change in the result with revaluation marks.
- All the Heads of the Departments, presented various activities taken up, achievements of faculty and students. They concluded their presentation by briefing the members about the various proposals.

Principal thanked the members for their valuable suggestions and inputs.
