

In pursuance of the same, Principal has requested members of the academic council to accord permission to conduct the same to GCET (autonomous) students also.

Item No. 11: To consider and approve the proposal and application of the college to go for “Deemed to be University” status

Proceedings and Discussion: Principal apprised the members that the college is planning to apply for Deemed to be University status and informed about the fulfillment of the preliminary eligibility criteria to apply for the same. All the members unanimously agreed for the proposal and appreciated the same.

Item No. 12: Any other Item with the permission of chair

Under any other item Controller of Examinations presented the revised revaluation guidelines, in line with JNTUH revaluation guidelines applicable from the academic year 2023-24.

Approval: The Academic Council approved the revised revaluation guidelines in line with JNTUH revaluation guidelines applicable from the academic year 2023-24

Revised revaluation guidelines approved by academic council as follows:

Process for Revaluation:

A Student may apply for revaluation for any course (subject) in a semester only once by paying the prescribed fee. In case, if the student is not satisfied with the outcome of revaluation, he/she may apply for challenge valuation by paying the prescribed fee.

1. If the marks obtained in the revaluation are less than the original marks (marks obtained in the initial valuation), then marks secured in the initial valuation remain unchanged, consequently, there is no change in the outcome.
2. If the difference between the marks secured in the revaluation (RV1) and original marks (marks obtained in the initial valuation) are less than 15% of the maximum marks (allocated to the semester end examination), then marks secured in the initial valuation remain and there is no change in the marks and consequently there is no change in the outcome.

3. If the marks secured in the revaluation are greater than or equal to 15% of the maximum marks (allocated to the semester end examination) compared to the original marks (marks obtained in the initial valuation), then the corresponding answer script shall be evaluated by another external examiner conducting second revaluation (RV2).
- If the marks secured in the latter (RV2) are lesser than 15% of the maximum marks (allocated to the semester end examination) compared to the original marks (marks obtained in the initial valuation), then the marks obtained in the initial valuation shall remain, and thus, there is no change in the outcome.
 - If the marks secured in the latter (RV2) are also greater than or equal to 15% of the maximum marks (allocated to the semester end examination) compared to the original marks (marks obtained in the initial valuation), then the marks obtained in the initial valuation shall be replaced with the **lower of the marks secured in both the revaluations (RV1 and RV2), subject to the condition that there is a change in the grade of the course (subject).**

Note: Revaluation is applicable for semester end examinations of Theory courses ONLY.
