Vocational Courses may be given focus to pave way for entrepreneurship. iv. students may be encouraged to take up entrepreneurship as early as possible. v. All eligible students may be encouraged to take GATE Examination.

10. Accreditations/Certifications applied/received, if any:	The Principal mentioned that the UGC Autonomous status is extended for 5 years i.e. from 2022 to 2027. The college is granted A+ Grade by NAAC. B.Tech Programs of EEE and ECE received accreditation from NBA under Tier -I for a period of three years , up to June 2025.	Members congratulated the Principal and his team for receiving A+ grade from NAAC.

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11. Status of implementation of current Research projects, if any	The Principal informed the members that one DRDO funded project for an amount of Rs 45.81 lakh has been completed in the month of September, 2022.	
13. Any other item(s) with the permission of the Chairman.	<p>The members were informed that AR22 Regulation and AR20 Syllabus is followed for B. Tech and M. Tech. This is done because the accreditation teams suggested to allow at least two batches to graduate to test the strength of PEOs. Prof. KVL Subramaniam also opined that unless at least two batches graduate, you can't get feedback from industry and other stakeholders on POs, PSOs and PEOs.</p> <p>Dr. M. Anji Reddy, requested the Principal to brief the major achievements of the college since last GB meeting.</p> <p>Principal replied that the number of students placements with higher pay package have increased apart from receiving NAAC A+ grade.</p> <p>The Chairman of the college shared that the college has facilitated completion of Mini Projects by students in college itself. 25,000 (Twenty five thousand) Sft of space is allotted for Incubation Center, Gym, Amphi Theatre, Game Zone, etc.</p>	<p>Prof. KVL Subramaniam appreciated the college management for providing more space for Incubation as companies incubating look out for space in Institutions.</p>
